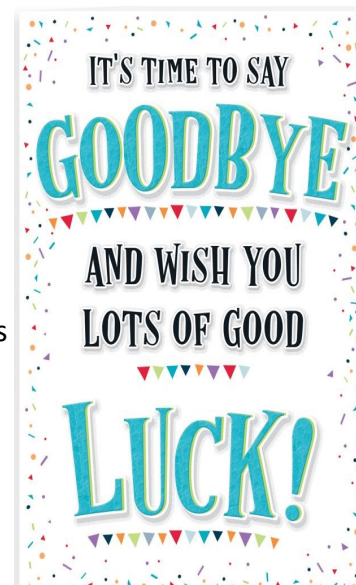
We are sad to announce that Mrs O'Neill our Building Services Supervisor is retiring after 17 years working tirelessly for the good of all school users at Sundridge.
