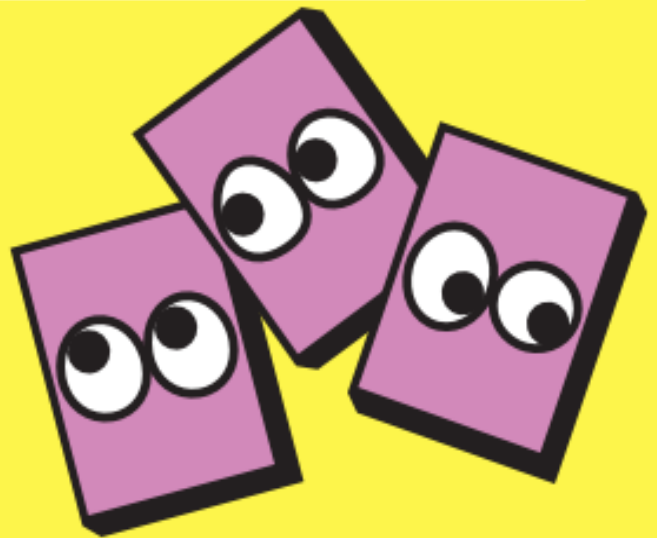

### Who can join?
