



## **SUNDRIDGE PRIMARY SCHOOL** **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

We believe that a school uniform is important for the following reasons: -

- ◆ It looks smart.
- ◆ Wears well.
- ◆ Contributes to sense of belonging.
- ◆ Gives a common purpose.
- ◆ Fosters a feeling of pride.

We ask that children wear the uniform and we encourage them to maintain a good standard of clean and tidy dress in school.

Our School Uniform is as follows: -

- ◆ Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan with/without the school logo.
- ◆ Grey/Black trousers/skirt.
- ◆ White polo shirt with/without the school logo.
- ◆ Black low heeled shoes (no coloured trainers)

### **For summer as above or: -**

- ◆ Grey/Black shorts with white polo shirt (logo optional).
- ◆ Blue checked dress.

All logo uniform can be ordered from the school supplier via the link on the school website (optional).

For safety reasons we ask that children do not wear jewellery in school. Earrings must be of the stud variety only.

### **P.E. Kit**

For health and safety reasons it is important that children are properly dressed for any physical activity.

- ◆ White T-Shirt (logo optional).
- ◆ Navy/black shorts or jogging bottoms.
- ◆ White socks.
- ◆ Black Plimsolls or Black Trainers

In addition it is suggested that for winter an extra sweatshirt and jogging bottoms are sent into school.

Pupils in Y1 – 6 will also need a swimming costume/trunks (no long shorts) and towel in the term their class goes swimming.

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM DRESS CODE.**

The Governors have set a uniform dress code. All children attending Sundridge will be required to wear:

Football shirts are not allowed.

**Please put your child's name in all items of clothing.**

Book bags and P.E bags in the school royal blue with/without the logo (optional).

**Please do not send your child to school wearing trainers.  
No football shirts are allowed.**

Children should not wear make-up, nail extensions or nail varnish to school. We ask children to remove jewellery except for watches and stud earrings before they come to school for health and safety reasons.

**Staff cannot be held responsible for any valuables brought into school by pupils.** If it is valuable – leave it at home! This also applies to any precious items that are of sentimental value to your child.
