The UK Safer Internet Centre

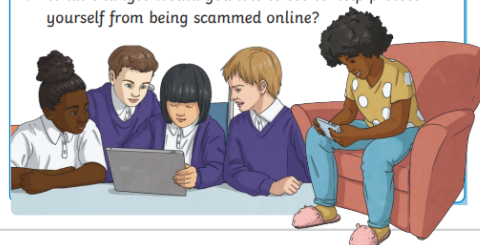
The UK Safer Internet Centre is coordinated by three leading charities: Childnet International, South West Grid for Learning and Internet Watch Foundation.

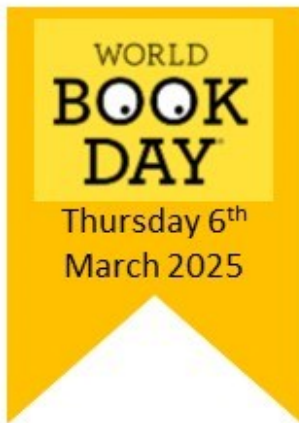
Safer Internet Day 2025
