Friday 11th April 2025

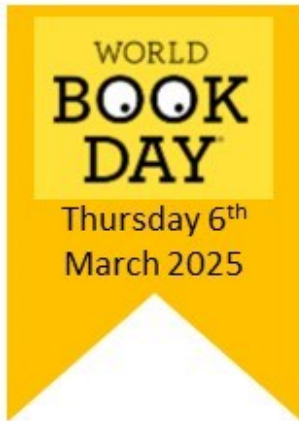
We will be holding our Easter Egg Raffle, at 9.00am.

What is Bikeability Level 1/2 Combined?

Bikeability is the government's national cycle training programme. Pupils take part in small groups

for one day and train with our qualified instructors on a 1:3 ratio.

There is no cost to take part.

Level 1 is a playground-based session to start the day, practising and building confidence in key

cycle control skills in a traffic-free setting. This session lasts approximately one hour. Pupils who are ready will then progress on to quiet roads near to school for the rest of the day. Level 2 will introduce them to cycling as an everyday, fun, healthy activity and an alternative mode of transport. If you would like to see what activities Level 2 will include, you can visit

All pupils in Year 5 will be able to take part in the Bikeability training regardless of their bike experience.
